

Apron - Down stage next to the pit

Arena - stage area in front of the proscenium.

Black box - A simple but somewhat undecorated performance space.

Border - Horizontal curtain

Cyclorama - Shine light or projections on them.

Deck - The stage

Downstage - Is towards the audience

House - The area where the audience is located.

Legs - Vertical curtains that are used to hide the actors.

Main curtain - The front curtain that's usually the same color as the house.

Pit - Down-front nearest seats to the stage.

Proscenium - A stage that's framed. Sometimes has an apron.

Raked stage - Stage floor that slants upward towards back of the stage.

Scrim - piece of such fabric used as a drop, border for creating the illusion of a solid wall.

Thrust - A stage that extends into the auditorium so that the audience is seated around 3 sides.

Traveler - opens and closes

upstage - Is away from the audience

Wings - The area immediately outside the scenery. Unseen by audience.
